Christmas is such a wonderful time of year! We enjoy the music, the food, the celebrations, and so much more that makes this time of year special. This year, the Lodi Academy Christmas concert is Sunday, December 10 at 6:30 in the gymnasium. The Lodian Singers and Band will be performing "Christmas songs from the silver screen." All are invited to come celebrate and enjoy the wonders of Christmas music!

At the heart of Christmas we celebrate the birth of Jesus. The story is told and retold of the Virgin Mary giving birth to baby Jesus, born in a stable, His birth announced by angels to the shepherds, who came to visit and wonder at the Messiah, and the visit from the Wise Men bearing gifts fit for a King. But how often do we remember the birth of another remarkable baby, Jesus' cousin, born only a few months earlier?

Zechariah and Elizabeth had tried for a baby, and could not have one. By the time Luke chapter 1 picks up the story, they are too old. Zechariah is a priest, serving in the Temple, when he is visited by the Angel Gabriel and told that he will have a son. His son would have a special mission: go before the Messiah and prepare the way. From the moment of his conception, John was on a mission to prepare people for the Messiah. Remarkably, when Mary (pregnant with Jesus), came to visit Elizabeth (pregnant with John), Elizabeth said, "as soon as the voice of your greeting sounded in my ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy."

The life mission of John the Baptist was to point people to Jesus, the Messiah, who came to take away their sins and bring healing to their sin ravaged life. Our calling today is to do the same: In a season where so much focus is on the birth of Jesus, remind people that Jesus was born to pay the price for sin, take our sins away, and heal us from the destruction of sin!

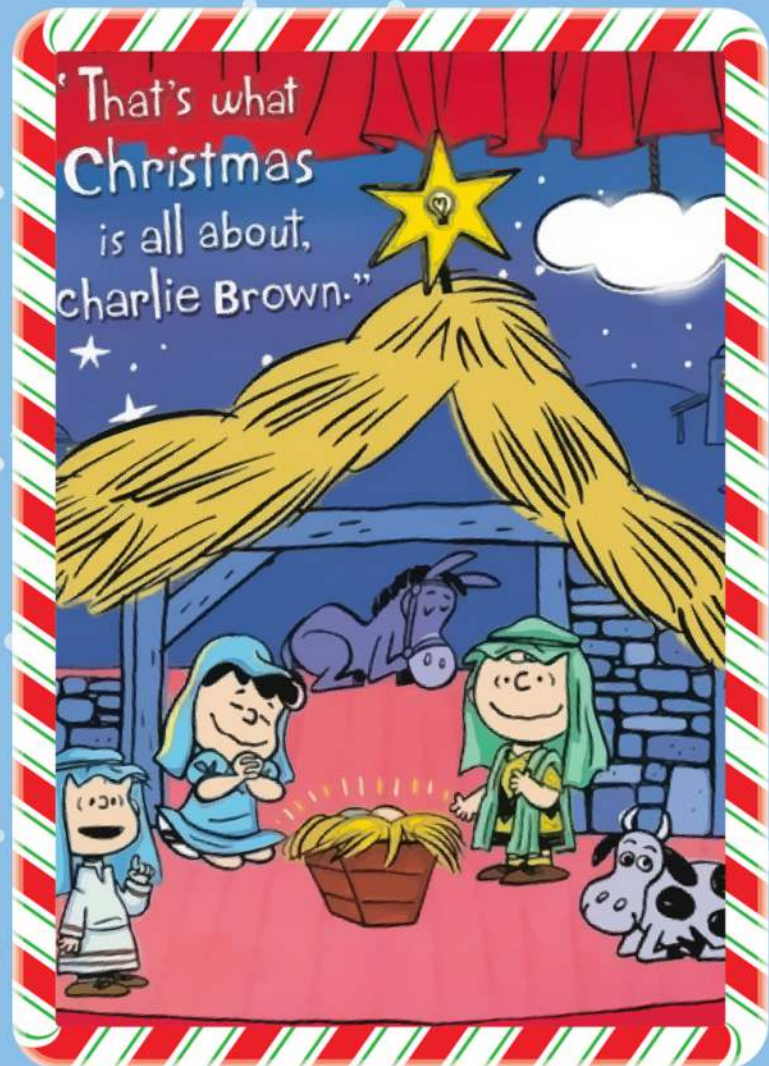
