## Greetings from Principal Stubbert:

August 28, 1963 Dr. Martin Luther King gave his famous speech on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington D.C., "I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed: 'We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal.'" Speaking out against the segregation and racism of his time, he also shared his dream for his children, "I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character."

Next week, on Martin Luther King Day, we remember this dream and the man who dedicated his life to fulfilling that dream. While we have made so many advances in the 59 years since that speech, we are reminded that Dr. Luther's dream begins when we as individuals choose to do what is right and see each other through the eyes of God as His children.
