On Friday, May 10th, The Physics and Ecology classes participated in a "Physics, Math & Science Day" at California's Great America. Weeks before the trip the students formed in small groups, selected projects, and did prep work to prepare for the trip. Two of our student teams participated in the Mars Lander Contest. Each team was given a maximum budget of \$5,000 with which to purchase their materials; such as balloons, straws, clear tape- to mention a few. With their materials the students constructed a lander vehicle designed to carry one raw egg. It was the two Lodi Academy teams facing off for the last round at a height of about 9.5 meters (31 feet). The winning team of Madie Jonson, Lizzie Narvaez, and Brayden Perkins were awarded first place prize. The second place award was earned by the team of Reesi Nash, Chris Vega Perez, and Chase Garner.
