**Psalm 139:23, 24: "Search me, O God; and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."**

The writer of Psalm 139 focuses on God's perfect knowledge of us. Perhaps we can relate to the author when he asks God to search him and know his anxieties. Experiencing anxiety is an all too common human experience. The secret to overcoming and managing anxiety is not to pretend it doesn't exist, or let it overwhelm us, but instead talking to God about it and giving it to Him. When we do, He will not be surprised! In Psalm 139:1-3, the writer reminds us that God everything about us, every moment of our lives, even our thoughts and what we say. This could be a frightening thought, but the writer also adds that, even knowing everything about us, He still loves us! "How precious are your thoughts to me, O God! How great are the sum of them (v. 17)!"

What does this mean for us today? God loves you so much, despite your failures, imperfections, anxieties, or stresses! He asks you to welcome Him into your life, so you can be real with Him. Share your anxieties, stresses, frustrations, heartbreak, joy, accomplishments, successes, and so much more. And, here is the amazing part, He will lift the burdens you carry, re-create you, and be your best friend for eternity! All you have to do is let Him!
