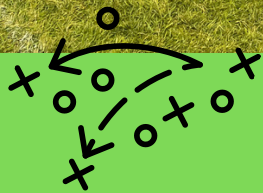
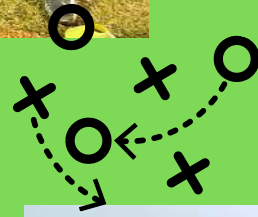


Flag Football Tournament @ Rio Lindo Adventist Academy October 13-16, 2022
