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Kiwanis Educational Scholarship Guidelines

The Kiwanis Club of Greater Lodi Foundation is awarding educational scholarships to high school seniors.

AWARDS

Educational scholarship awards will be of \$1,500.00. The number of scholarships awarded annually varies depending upon availability of Kiwanis funds. Scholarships are not renewable and must be redeemed within 1-year of being awarded.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a scholarship applicants must be graduating from high schools within the Greater Lodi Area with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Applicant must be a United States citizen.

Before receiving funds, recipient must provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student of an accredited vocational school, or an undergraduate at a 2-year or 4-year institution of higher learning.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- 1. Completed application all questions (marked by *) are required and must be completed
- 2. Personal statement essay
- 3. Official sealed transcript
- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation

Preference will be given to applicants with community service experience.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete the Kiwanis Club of Greater Lodi Scholarship Application making sure all required (*) questions are answered. *If you do not <u>sign and date</u> the application, your application will be considered incomplete and disqualified from the selection process.* Your application must be postmarked by **April** 15.
- 2. Attach a *signed and dated* personal statement essay, consisting of no more than two (2) single-sided pages.

In your personal essay please include:

- What life experiences have shaped who you are today and what challenges have you overcome in achieving your education (i.e. financial, personal, medical, etc.)
- What are your academic and career goals and your plans and how do you plan to achieve them.
- If you do not sign and date your personal statement essay, your application will be determined incomplete and disqualified from the selection process.
- 3. Include an official complete high school transcript in a sealed envelope.
- Include two (2) <u>recent</u> letters of recommendation. Letters must be limited to one side of a single sheet (8.5" x 11") of paper, typed, <u>signed and dated</u> by the author along with their contact information, i.e., phone number, email address.
 - Include one (1) letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, coach or school official not related to the applicant. The letter may cover the applicant's ability, work habits, leadership, personality and integrity.
 - Include one (1) letter of recommendation from a community member, family friend, or employer not related to the applicant and **not a high school official, teacher or coach**. The recommendation should cover the applicant's work habits, ability or participation in the community in terms of service and/or leadership skills.
 - If you do not include two, signed and dated letters of recommendation, your application will be determined incomplete and disqualified from the selection process.
